The Family Center of Washington County fosters the positive growth and development of young children and their families. We offer services for children, youth and families, including: Early Care and Education, Children's Integrated Services-Early Intervention, Family Support Home Visiting, Specialized Child Care supports, Transportation, Child Care Provider supports, Reach Up and Job Development, Family Works, Child Care Financial Assistance, Child Care Referral, Welcome Baby visits, Strengthening Families Demonstration Project, Parent Education, and Playgroups for children from birth to five. Among the 30 individuals in Moretown who benefited from the Family Center's programs and services from July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015 were:

- \* 1 family who consulted our Child Care and other Resource and Referral services, receiving assistance in finding child care to meet their needs, answering questions related to child care and child development, and receiving information about other community resources available to them.
- \* 5 families who received Child Care Financial Assistance.
- \* 3 licensed and registered child care providers and other support agencies who consulted our Child Care Provider Support services, and received monthly newsletters and training on a wide variety of topics through home visits, conferences, and workshops.
- \* 3 adults and children who participated in Parent Education workshops and related activities for children.
- \*12 individuals who were served by one of our **Home Visiting** services, providing parent and family education and support.
- \* 6 **children and caregivers** who received food and household items from our newly created **Food Pantry** to help supplement their nutritional and basic needs of families we serve.
