

# Capstone in the Mad River Valley offering free tax filing service

Capstone Community Action can assist Vermonters with filing their **Federal and State income tax returns**. We can serve taxpayers who had income in 2016 of up to \$54,000. We also assist those who only need to file a Vermont Renter's Rebate or Homestead Declaration. Capstone Community Action has been helping people file their Federal and State Income Tax Returns for 20 years through the IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program. All VITA volunteers are IRS-trained and certified.

Capstone in the Mad River Valley, located at Evergreen Place in Waitsfield, will be offering tax assistance on Tuesdays and Wednesdays beginning on Tuesday, February 7.

On Tuesdays, the service will be available for walk-ins only between the hours of 1 pm & 4:30 pm.

On Wednesdays, the service is by appointment only; hours are from 5pm-8pm. Call 496-6900 to make an appointment. Wednesday appointments must be scheduled by the end of the day on the preceding Tuesday – that is, we cannot make same day appointments.
