7:02 Librarian's Report May 2020

Expansion of current services/Interlibrary loan/Re-opening plan

- Cory shared a video and resources about considerations for re-opening.
- Emily asked what does our community want? Can we stay curbside for a while?
- Cory would be willing to do Tuesday 2-6, Thursday 2 6 and Saturday. This
 would expand the services, but not open the building.
- Michelle observed that there are a lot of community needs that are met with curbside.
- Jamie noted that access to the computer and wifi in the building would be good.
- Jen said that there are phases that we can look at and weigh the risk. Jamie added that we may need to open and then close and phases we may need to go into and out of.
- The Courier system starts next week and we aren't ready yet. What is the
 protocol for this? We can start June 1st. The timeline would include leaving
 books for five days and then getting to the patron, and then returning. Cory feels
 able to provide ILL and then offer ILL starting in June. The books in a bin may
 need to be left out for the courier.
- Grant opportunities still planning on applying to the Rotary for summer intern.
 The state-wide grants are there for Covid readiness.

- Programming successes: Any Book Book Club, VT Folklife Story Circle (Cory did one), Star Wars Trivia Night. Future: Birding by Ear outside with pre-reg and limit to 6-8 people, Marvel Trivia Night tomorrow, Summer Reading Program in August (802 Reptile booked)
- VOSHA training that Cory completed has been shared with the Town Offices.
- Signs for WiFi parking updated
- Jamie brainstormed things that people may need: move modem to the other side of the building closer to the parking lot, wifi booster, have tablets for folks to use,
- Do we need to move over more books from the other building? Where would the books go? What books would we move? What is the plan for transitioning space for Town Hall use?
