## Moretown Planning Commission Minutes March 17, 2015 6:30 PM Moretown Elementary School

The Commission discussed what needs to be amended in the zoning regulations to bring them into alignment with the town plan.

JB indicated that his experience indicates that the zoning regulation needs to redefine "cottage industry". It may also be a good idea to include a section entitled "Special Events".

Karen said that the plan addresses flood resiliency and flood plains in far more detail than before (in the wake of Tropical Storm Irene) and those issues should be addressed in the regulations.

JB asked about subdivision regulations. He said that smoke, dirt, and noxious odors are in the current performance standards. We could use performance standards to address the business of hosting of special events.

Steep slopes are another area that the plan addresses and the zoning regulations should as well.

And the plan discusses supporting farms and farm related activities that help keep farms viable.

Dara said that the regional commission posted future land use maps for the towns in Washington County. We should all look at the proposed map for Moretown – which does not necessarily reflect the Moretown plan land use map. JB suggested we look at two additional items in the zoning regulations – buffers along wetlands and rivers, and the terms used for lighting requirements.
