

**Moretown Planning Commission**

**6:30 pm, July 16, 2019**

Jonathan called the meeting to order at 6:40.

The planning commission discussed the LMHP, and made final tweaks. Members asked Duane Pierson, who was principal at the exceptional Moretown Elementary School when Tropical Storm Irene hit, if the school ever purchased a generator for the school as had been planned. He told the commission that after the school itself flooded and people there had to move uphill, the purchase of a generator was re-assessed. The purchase was not made.

Jonathan said he surveyed damage on July 6 during storm to assess vulnerable areas of Moretown's road network.

John made a motion to accept the plan as amended and present it to the selectboard. Deb seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Karen proposed a concept for a municipal planning grant. The Towns of Fayston and Waisfield procured a grant for a natural resources inventory of the town in 2006. The commission decided to continue discussion of such an application including what might be the up and downsides of an inventory.

Deb made a motion to approve minutes of June 4. John seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved. There are no official minutes of the June 18 meeting as there was not a quorum present and no action was taken.

John made a motion to adjourn at 8:00. Karen seconded the motion.
