Jonathan called the meeting to order at 6:40 pm. John made a motion to adopt minutes of September 3. Karen Horn seconded the motion which was adopted unanimously

Jonathan announced that the next meeting is cancelled so the planning commission can go to the Harwood Unified Union Supervisory District meeting.

Dara introduced the energy committee activities for the evening to attendees.

She asked attendees to consider how Moretown is using energy today and to look to the future in order to develop tangible strategies for implementing an enhanced energy plan.

Zach and Clare brought maps of the town and described them to attendees. The maps will go into the plan. The maps include current renewable energy installations in town, zoning districts, habitat corridors and other features of the community.

Moretown needs to generate 10,600 mw more renewable energy than current amount (including landfill methane, hydro energy). Any new generation installed after 2016/2017 is considered new.

A general discussion ensued.

John made a motion to adjourn at 8:30. Deborah seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
