

Moretown Planning Commission 6:30 PM, June 16, 2021 Meeting Via ZOOM

Jonathan started the Zoom meeting but was not able to remain for the rest of the meeting. Karen called the meeting to order at 6:38.

The board agreed that given the change in the Governor's Emergency Order on June 15, the Planning Commission would meet the next time in person at the Town office. However, Planning Commission members would like to retain the Zoom option so as to be more accessible to members of the public who might want to attend or for members of the Planning Commission who might choose to continue partially remote. John made a motion to suggest to the selectboard that they invest a portion of ARPA dollars in a screen and camera for the town office that all town committees could use. David seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

The planning commission discussed proposed amendments from Clare based upon earlier conversations and the walk around the village on May 25. The Planning Commission will ask Jay Pilliod, Moretown Energy Committee to send us model standards for lighting efficiency and down cast lighting that Efficiency Vermont might have. Members also discussed community engagement around the zoning ordinance update.

The Planning Commission will not meet on July 7th. The next meeting will be July 21, in person at the town office.

John made a motion to adjourn at 8:10. Deb seconded the motion which was unanimously approved.
