4. Budget

Chris will talk to the Select Board about re-appropriating the \$1,000 budget item for the matching trail grant to be used to pay for the new pickle ball nets and the painting of the 4 new courts. This work enables tennis and two pickle ball teams or 4 pickle ball teams, or 2 tennis teams to play at once, greatly increasing our capacity and ability to share the court. The courts have been getting a lot of use. The matching trail grant fund will not be needed this year, no paid work is planned for the trail at this time.

5. Succession Planning & Partnerships

Mandi has moved on from her position as Principal of the Moretown Elementary School (MES), Kate Liptak is just starting in her new role. Chris has a scheduled meet and greet meeting setup for early August. Becky will join. The agenda is to discuss (1) the Stark Mountain Foundation HUUSD kids ski scholarship program and how it can support the MES winter sports program (2) the rec committee construct, active projects and historical partnerships with the school including

the joint MOU, and (3) the Town Forest Management Plan revision and the pending draft review cycle.

Saiward is interested in joining the committee and is considering approaching the Select Board for approval as a next step. Yay!

The Mad River Riders have added this to their annual maintenance calendar with two weed whacking sessions planned for June and July. Grass and/or clover is to be planted this fall / early spring to reduce some of the weed issues.

Gregg and others have continued to work on the new trail section and its coming along nicely despite all the rains this summer.

7. Fence

Chris connected with Mike White who came last week and fixed the fence. Invoice pending should be ~\$840 compared to the \$800 budgeted.

8. Courts

New court lines have been drawn as described above. FPF will post both pickleball and tennis opportunities to increase utilization, thank you Susan and Neal! The courts are buzzing with happy people!

Working to get the Mad River Riders and Bee the Change at the event. Suggestion for next year that the Morefest Committee work more closely with the rec committee and coordinate event timing, closures, use changes, etc.
