Since all articles involving over \$5,000.00 are to be voted on by Australian ballot, it's important for the voters to attend this informational meeting to discuss the following articles.

Article 5: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown vote the sum of \$1,878,380.18 for the support of the Town, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026, for any operating expenses and other obligations. Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 6: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown vote to set aside the sum of \$10,000 for the repair and upkeep of the bridges and culverts of the Town. Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 7: Shall the Town of Moretown appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to fund the Maintenance Reserve Fund. Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 8: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown appropriate the sum of \$6,250.00 to support the work of the Waterbury Area Senior Center? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 15: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown authorize its Select Board to expend a sum of money not to exceed \$225,000 plus interest and arrange financing for not more than 15 years, for the purchase of a loader for the Highway Department? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 16: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown authorize its Select Board to expend a sum of money not to exceed \$125,000 plus interest and arrange financing for not more than 5 years, for the purchase of a 5500 truck (cab, chassis, with body, sander and plow)? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 17: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown authorize its Select Board to expend a sum of money not to exceed \$18,000, for the purchase of a blower for the grader? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 18: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown authorize its Select Board to expend a sum of money not to exceed \$10,000 for the purchase of two sets of turn out gear for the fire department? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 19: Shall the voters of the Town of Moretown appropriate the sum of \$600 for an informational mailer for the community regarding the details of revitalization of the Moretown Town Hall? Voting to be by Australian ballot

Article 20: Shall the town provide notice of the availability of the annual report by postcard, mailed to all registered voters at least 30 days before the annual meeting instead of mailing or otherwise distributing the report to the voters of the town pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1682(a)? Voting to be by Australian ballot
