Town Meeting articles – Michelle brought news about two articles that are contentious every year at Town Meeting. **#5** - to offer a discount on taxes; and **#32** - to use monies in the Recreation Fund, do not need to be articles as originally thought according to Sarah Jarvis at VLCT. Both articles will be removed from the 2016 Town Meeting Warning. The board will review the warning to see if there are other articles in question for discussion on 4/6/15.

Capital Budget – Michelle said there are some pretty big expenditures listed in the capital budget for 2016 and wonders if we could spread out the purchases. Discussion included having a committee to plan and explore best uses, costs, needs etc., for the equipment. More discussion will continue on 4/6/15.

Liaisons – will be established on 3/16/15.

Review of invoices and approval of warrants – A \$100 invoice from Fleischer Jacobs Group, which according to Craig Eilers is broker fees for the town's health insurance, now that Vermont Health Connect is no more.

The board questioned whether or not Blue Cross is already charging the town for managing the health reimbursement account as part of the premium. The FJG invoice was removed from the warrant until the invoice can be clarified, otherwise warrant 10 & 11 were approved.

Tom moved to adjourn at 6:40 p.m. and John seconded. All were in favor.
