## Town of Moretown - minutes of the 6/29/15 special meeting of the Selectboard

Present: Tom M, John H, Rae W, Jason A, Martin C, and Brian Ward, Ron Papineau, Colby Martell (Fountain Forestry), Anthony Mazzilli.

TM: Called to order.

Colby: 1) asks to cut back the bank on the upper curve 4 to 5 feet, going back to the town right of way. 2) Next curve needs to be cut.

JH: Whose property?

Answer: Irene Sherman.

Q: is this section Class IV or a trail?

Colby: By GIS, it's Class IV.

TM: We'll give a clear definition where the Class IV / Trail line is.

Colby: We will seed and mulch it.

Martin C: The road is clay and may move under heavy load. It will need gravel [and stone].

3) The culvert is failing. The landowner wants to keep his pond. It needs a standpipe to keep pond. The owner will buy the needed culvert.

TM: If the owner gets a permit...

Ron P: A neighbor has equipment and will do it.

TM: When?

Ron P: July, August, once it's dry.

TM: So let's do that.

RW: How long will harvesting last?

Colby: 1 ½ to 2 months.

RW: Are the neighbors OK with trucks going by early in the morning?

Anthony M: We're OK.

Colby: The contractor we are using will be agreeable.

TM: Be reasonable with adding gravel and stone.

Colby (seems to agree)

TM: A culvert permit is needed. Colby has to contact the landowner.

Colby: Timeframe, they need to be out short-cutting 2 weeks, roadwork 2 weeks after. [In response to a question] I do not see this going until school.
