Meeting called to order: 6:05 PM

Public Comment: None

John moved to go into executive session, at 6:10 PM, for considering a clear and imminent peril to the public safety. Rae seconded. All were in favor. John moved that the board exit executive session at 6:24 PM, Rae seconded. All were in favor.

John moved that the board go back into executive session, after making a specific finding that premature general public knowledge would clearly place the public body or a person involved at a substantial disadvantage: confidential attorney-client communications made for the purpose of providing professional legal services to the body.
