Tom called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm

Public Comment – there was none

Library Trustee – April Shaw was present to ask that the SB to appoint Dawn Hayward as Library Trustee. Tom **made the motion** to appoint Dawn Hayward as Library Trustee until March 2027. Callie seconded. All were in favor.

Green Mountain Valley School (GMVS) Event Sept 11th – Sam Jackson was present to speak with the SB about the biking and running event that they have going on September 11th. The whole school is participating and there will be approximately ten teams of ten or eleven students on each team. They plan on having signage out so that people are aware. The event should bring the students to Moretown in the vicinity of 1:00 – 2:30 pm that day. As last year, they plan on using the town trails for some of the event. The SB is fine with it.

Reports & Communications – documents to be approved 2 amendments – one for the sidewalk project from Dubois & King (this will be looked at and addressed at the next meeting), one for engineering services for the Ward Brook culvert. Stewart's Shop liquor/tobacco license and Salt Shed contract for Dubois & King.

Martin asked that the question of who's responsibility it is to weed whack the tennis courts be addressed to the SB. Tom said that the task goes along with the mowing of the fields and other areas that the road crew takes care of. That was the intent of the fourth guy on the crew. Tom said that he would touch base with Martin.

Mike brought up the discussion on the Meadow Road bridge, just to have in the back of minds.

Don said that the mailboxes are still being worked on and still have some bugs to work out.

Don brought up the topic of a Town Admin and reaching out to VLCT for some direction.

Sam said that the Cabot Building in Waitsfield is being looked at as a possible location for a school. Proposals from firms are being acquired, just to see what would be possible for that building.

Callie brought up a concern around Herring Brook Road and having the sheriff patrol around 6:30 am. Sasha will get Bret on that.

Callie mentioned that the three that were chosen for the Class IV/LT committee haven't met yet, Mike will get in contact with Martin about it.

Callie mentioned going to a tax collector conference for her job, Tom asked that she send that information along to Sasha.

Tom received a call from someone for the speed trailer to be placed on Route 100 near Camp Navajo. Sasha will get with Stefan on that.

Tom mentioned that a call from CAI Technologies was received saying that Travis Blodgett had called them, stating that a SB member asked him to call them. No SB member had done that. There was brief discussion on why the call was placed and Carol assured Travis that the information was sent to CAI and it does take some time to get things changed.

Pony Farm Parking Issues – Angie and her partner were in to speak with the SB regarding the issues of parking on Pony Farm Road. There was a meeting set up with Mike, Don and Martin for 8/27/2026 to look at the situation. They said that they spoke with the road crew and they will not be parking on Pony Farm in the winter months.

New Business – there was none

Old Business – Tom asked that Sasha send out the annual budget email this week to all the departments.
