- Speeds Rte 2 and 100B – Don to forward packet (attached) that was submitted for lowering speed on Rte 2 from Gallagher Acres to Rte 100 intersection . Committee to then gear up for tackle this item. Melanie reviewing trail access and status to CBM School.
- Crosswalks in Village
 - Crosswalk at School to be repainted this spring
 - New Crosswalk – 1111 permit application to be filed with Vt Trans. Don and Melanie to look into grant possibility with bike/ped collation for work associated with constructing this crosswalk.
- RSFS radar relocation status- Don meeting with District 6 to review ways and means of relocation. Portable radar unit trailer being registered. Committee to help advise town of possible locations. Tom reviewing/confirming with Sheriff's Department location placement requirements. Traffic Control Speed Measuring system to be installed on 6 town roads this will help facilitate portable radar locations as well as where the sheriffs will be patrolling.
- Dirt Road Speeds
 - Changing speed limits on our dirt roads. Committee to review process, sign costs, roads where 35 miles an hour makes no sense. Spacing distance requirements of speed signs needs to be addressed. Issue of people stealing signs- grease the poles.
- Education and Consideration of others-
 - We have 4 slow down signs to place – “drive like your kids live here”.
 - Utilize FPF and work with Moretown School
